The Liberia Revenue Authority (LRA) and the Liberia Media for Democratic Initiatives (LMDI) will today Friday hold the second in a series of the first ever taxation specific General Knowledge Pop Quizzing Competition for Liberian High Schools to enhance the knowledge of Rural Dwellers on the country's general tax regime.

As part of the recently launched National Tax Education and Enlightenment Road Show the second session of the National General Knowledge Pop Quizzing will happen at UNIFICATION TOWN or SMELL-NO-TASTE near the ROBERTS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (RIA) or HARBEL FIRESTONE with four schools of Margibi County competing in exhibition matches ahead of the start of the LMDI YEAR THREE National quizzing competition.
